By investing in young people, A Star Society contributes to their long-term success and well-being, helping them become confident, well-rounded, and impactful members of society.

VISION

Jheric is a pioneer in the Vancouver street dance scene and has taught many of Vancouver's hip hop teachers. He maintains a hectic schedule as an international instructor, choreographer, adjudicator and performer. Amongst many notable career highlights, he was chosen to choreograph and perform in the Vancouver Olympics 2010 Closing Ceremonies.



OUR PROGRAMS

SCHOOL HIP HOP WORKSHOPS

A Star Society has delivered its School Hip Hop Workshop to close to **half a million students** in over 100 lower mainland schools. Designed for children from Kindergarten to Grade 12, these workshops offer a week of expert hip hop instruction, culminating in a performance that brings together the entire school **community**, including parents, teachers, administration, staff and classmates.

The *benefits* of School Hip Hop Workshops go well-beyond the dance floor. Research shows that programs like these support the development of *executive functions* in children and youth, including *creativity*, *cognitive flexibility*, discipline, inhibitory self control, and working memory. These *critical skills* are correlated with *success* in school, work, relationships, and life. Through fundraising, it's our hope to expand access to this valuable program.



Not only does A Star Society's wonderful program help develop physical skills and abilities, but the program also emphasizes **positive attitudes, encouragement** of others, and **hard work** and **sportsmanship**.

The staff was *fantastic* with our students, and certainly modeled *enthusiasm* and *care* for the students. This program provides an *incredible opportunity* for students to excel and especially those students who may not excel in other sports.

FREESTYLE FRIDAYS & THE DROP

Freestyle Fridays and The Drop are low-cost drop-in programs bringing in Vancouver's top professional dance educators. They provide an opportunity for youth of all ages, cultures and schools to come together to collaborate, **share their creativity** and **build community**.

Studies show that youth are most vulnerable during the after school hours. Our drop-in programs provide a safe place to go. Everyone is welcome to gather, be inspired, and feel a sense of belonging, purpose and accomplishment.

Many students from our drop-in programs have gone on to form dance crews where they're able to use their talents to choreograph and perform works with meaningful messages. For example, The Collective won top awards at numerous competitions performing their own choreography. Our Heart Mind Body group created choreography under the mentorship of Kim Meredith inspired by a Shane Koyczan poem and performed for many audiences, including the Dalai Lama.

BURSARIES

A Star Society provides students who are in **financial need** with bursaries for ongoing dance education. For those who have always dreamed of pursuing their **passion for dance**, but lack the financial means to do so, a bursary can be a **life-changing** opportunity.

Providing these bursaries helps *break down barriers* and promote *diversity* in the performing arts. By giving individuals from all backgrounds the chance to pursue their passion for dance, we can create a more *vibrant and inclusive dance community*. With access to arts education, individuals develop *teamwork*, discipline, *creativity*, and self-expression – skills that can be applied in all aspects of life.

A Star Society works closely with Boogaloo Academy to provide this education. Boogaloo Academy provides space, classes, and other ‘in kind’ support for A Star Society’s programs and events.
